The term for the current Executive Committee members will end on March 31, 2012. If you would like to be a candidate for the election, please send your letter of intent. Simply copy and return the text at the bottom of this announcement to indicate your desire to be a nominee, or to nominate another person to be a candidate in the election.

You must be an “Active Member” to make nominations, vote, and participate in the election. An alumnus who has paid membership fee is considered “Active Member”. Membership fee is due (until the extended period) by: November 30, 2011 (Alumni registration is available online at www.jspsusa.org and a form is on the reverse)

The open positions are comprised of five “Science Groups” – 1) Biology and Medical Sciences; 2) Chemistry; 3) Engineering; 4) Physics and Math; 5) Social Sciences and Humanities. You must indicate the Science Group of the person (or yourself) that you are nominating. Additionally, there is one “At-Large” position available. This person can be of any Science Group.

If you do not know which Science Group the person you are nominating belongs to, please contact that person. If you do not belong to a Science Group, please join one which is appropriate to your field.

Once we receive the nominations, a ballot will be sent to you with the names of candidates by Science Group. You do not need to belong to a Science Group to vote. You can vote for any candidate of any Science Group; and at-large candidate.
